### **Worship and Devotional Schedule Review**

#### First Saturdays 8:30 AM Mass

Beginning immediately, Saturday morning Mass will be offered on the First Saturday of each month only at 8:30 AM. Mass will be followed by a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament concluding with Benediction by 10am.

#### **First Fridays**

The evening Mass will no longer be offered, however two morning Mass will be offered at 8:30am and at 10:30am. The 10:30 Mass will be a school Mass, but all parishioners are welcome to attend.

#### **Holy Days of Obligation**

For the time being, the Mass schedule will be announced with each Holy Day. Please see last week's bulletin regarding the ongoing discussion about the Holy Day Mass schedule.

#### **Wednesdays**

Beginning October 4<sup>th</sup> every Wednesday through August will be a day dedicated to prayer for Vocations to Holy Orders and to the Consecrated (Religious) Life. Following the 8:30 Mass each Wednesday there will be a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament concluding with Benediction.

#### Wednesdays and Fridays

From the earliest days of the Christian community, Wednesdays and Fridays were special days of prayer and fasting. Abstaining from meat, especially on Fridays also became part the common observance. Each parishioner is encouraged to keep, in some form, the sacrificial and penitential aspect of these two days throughout the year. This could involve a special time of prayer (see the paragraph above) as well as some particular sacrifice offered for a personal intention.

#### The Rosary

The Rosary will be prayed in common on the First Sunday of each month immediately following the 10:30 Mass.

#### The Miraculous Medal Novena

The Novena prayers are recited following the 8:30 am Mass each Monday.

#### **The Divine Mercy Chaplet**

The Chaplet is prayed on the Second Sunday of each month immediately following the 10:30 Mass.
