In the liturgy, then, the Church would have us realize that we meet the same Christ who went about everywhere doing good, and who is still present in the midst of wherever two or three are gathered together in His name. And we meet him by sharing in His life and His redemption. We meet Christ in order to be Christ and, with Him, save the world.


