Just over three years ago, Queen of All Saints, along with every other parish in the diocese, began a five-year capital campaign.

At that time, parishioners and friends of Queen of All Saints made commitments to the campaign amounting to a total of over \$900,000.00. Our commitment to the diocesan share was \$300,000.00 with the rest coming to the parish.

I want to thank those who made commitments to the campaign and particularly those who have been fulfilling their commitment along the way during the past three years. Those regular payments have enabled us to go forward with the work we outlined when the campaign began.

With great gratitude, I want to encourage you to keep up with your commitment. If you have fallen behind, or have yet to begin, please make every effort to restart or begin the fulfillment of your pledge.

The remaining areas of work on the parish include urgent structural repairs in the rectory; the renovation of the kitchen in St Joseph's Hall; an upgraded sound system in St Joseph's Hall; and a second restroom in St Joseph's Hall. We can only begin these projects when we have the full participation of those who made commitments to the campaign. Thank you for your great spirit of sacrificial giving and your support of Queen of All Saints.


