The overnight retreat at Immaculate Conception Seminary last weekend was a great experience for all who were able to attend. ONGOING WORK

Work is proceeding in two areas of the building.

The kitchen in St Joseph's Hall is in the middle of a complete and much needed renovation. This room was originally the sacristy for the Lower Church when Mass was offered both upstairs and downstairs to accommodate all the congregants. We discovered a beautiful maple floor under layers of linoleum. The floor was sanded, stained, sealed and fully restored for the "new" kitchen. The original sanctuary floor is terrazzo like the floor in the rest of the hall. When the entire space was no longer needed for Mass, an extension was put on to the sanctuary floor for the construction of a stage. That extension was covered in linoleum tiles that are in very poor condition and they will be replaced as part of the overall project. When the renovations are complete, all frequently used kitchen items will be stored in the new cabinet spaces. The current storage room will be dedicated to the storage of religious education materials. We are also exploring a new sound system for St Joseph's Hall that will hopefully be installed by the end of the year.

In the church, the alternate sacristy (to the right of the sanctuary as you look toward the altar) has been used for Confessions and for storage. Workers have been clearing out the room and repairing and painting the walls for its eventual use as a confessional and small chapel. Here again, there seems to be a very good wood floor that hopefully can be restored as well.
