



## **Worship Schedule**

As you read in the letter from Bishop DiMarzio in last week's bulletin, each parish in the diocese is being asked to evaluate its Sunday Mass schedule and, where possible, to consider how it might consolidate the schedule into fewer, but better attended Masses. The bishop presented the rationale for this effort and how it makes good sense for parishes particularly where there several Masses in the Saturday evening/Sunday schedules.

I will be meeting with the parish council and other parishioners to look at our schedule here and not only Sunday Masses, but also our entire schedule of worship, prayer and devotion. As I mentioned last Sunday, we have rather healthy attendance at our Sunday Masses including Saturday evening. With only three Masses it would be hard to imagine consolidation, especially with a growing parish, but this will be an opportunity to have a good discussion of our liturgical and spiritual goals in accord with the bishop's wishes and suggestions.

## **A Few Reminders about Changes for Summer**

During the months of July and August we do not have Saturday morning Mass.

In addition First Friday and First Saturday devotions are not held. Saturday morning Mass and First Friday/First Saturday devotions will be part of our discussions above. The same is true for the communal praying of the Rosary on Sunday mornings at 10am. While the Rosary may not be prayed communally on Sundays, I do encourage each parishioner to pray the Rosary according to your own schedule and at the time of day that is most helpful for you. The Rosary is a very powerful prayer that can help us all in many ways.

## **Preparation for Mass and Thanksgiving After Mass**

Preparation for Mass can begin as soon as we wake up in the morning or on the walk or drive to church. We should, however, remember the need and the place for proximate preparation for Mass...that is in church before Mass begins. Let's try to keep that sacred time of quiet preparation for ourselves and one another. The same is true for the moments after Mass concludes: a quiet and prayerful atmosphere in church that is uninterrupted by personal chats, is what we should respect and preserve for one another.
