



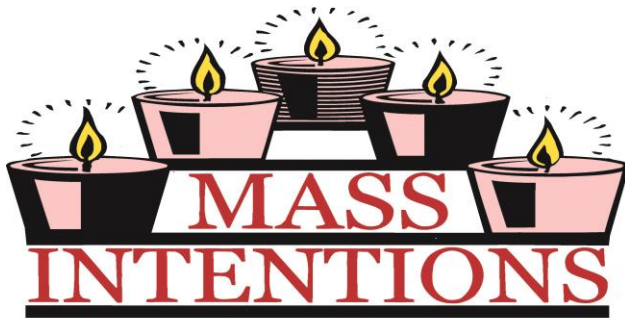
THANK YOU
