GENERATIONS OF FAITH

Three and a half years ago we began a five-year financial campaign. At the time, nearly \$1,000,000.00 was pledged by QAS parishioners and friends. Our diocesan commitment to the campaign was \$150,000.00 plus \$30,000.00 for the first year's Annual Catholic Appeal. We have met that commitment of \$180,000.00 to the diocese and now everything that is being received through the campaign comes to the parish!

You may recall at the time we began the campaign that we had several parish goals:

- New wiring and LED lighting throughout the church (completed)
- A new space/chapel for the Sacrament of Penance
- Pointing and roof repair in the rectory (now most urgently needed)

In St Joseph's Hall:

- A renovated kitchen
- New LED lighting (just completed, along with necessary rewiring)
- Upgraded sound system
- An additional restroom and renovation of the existing restroom

Apart from the pointing and roof repair, which are urgently needed to avoid structural damage, each of these goals or projects was chosen to enhance parish life in worship and in other spaces where we regularly meet and gather.

Thank you to those who have completed their pledges and to those who continue to make regular payments. If you have fallen behind, please make every effort to restart your donations. The campaign concludes in a year and a half!
