Building Repairs and Restorations

Over the next couple of weeks I will be outlining for you the repairs that are needed on the rectory roof, church roof and other exterior areas and the potential costs involved. The repairs to the rectory roof, the exterior walls and the windows are an urgent priority in order to avoid more significant structural damage. There are also areas of the roof over the school that need repair. We will soon begin the repair of the steps to the courtyard on Vanderbilt Avenue. Like so many buildings in our neighborhood, Queen of All Saints is an old, albeit magnificent building. The extensive copper roofing combined with years of small repairs and patching have made the issue even more complex, but we can no longer postpone the work that needs to be done. In addition to explaining the work to be done, we'll provide photos in the bulletin of the damaged areas.
