All Catholics from age 18 through 60 are obliged to fast* on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

All Catholics age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

*Fasting involves one simple main meal with, if needed, two smaller meals for sustenance.
