I want to wish you and your families a most blessed Easter. Our prayer for one another is that the presence of the Risen Lord will be a source of strength, courage and hope for us and for the entire Church.

The Easter Season extends through Pentecost Sunday June 9th.

The first eight days of Easter (Sunday to Sunday) form the Octave of Easter when each day is celebrated as the Solemnity of the Lord's Resurrection. The Gospels that we read at Mass for these octave days are among the most beautiful as they tell of the encounters between the Risen Lord and His disciples. As we read them and reflect upon them, we should be reminded that Christ is personally present and close to us as he was in those appearances. If you can, come to Mass during the Octave where we not only meet Christ in the Scriptures but most truly and personally in the Holy Eucharist. The Second Sunday of Easter, which concludes the Octave, is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed after the 10:30 Mass.

The readings for Mass, Monday through Saturday in the Octave of Easter:

Monday – Acts 2: 14, 22-23; Matthew 28: 8-15

Tuesday – Acts 2: 36-41; John 20:11-18

Wednesday – Acts 3: 1-10; Luke 24: 13-35

Thursday – Acts 3: 11-26; Luke 24: 35-48

Friday – Acts 4: 1-12; John 21: 1-14

Saturday – Acts 4: 13-21; Mark 16: 9-25
