



## **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**

On this Trinity Sunday, an offering for reflection from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

(234) The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the “hierarchy of the truths of faith”. The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men” and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin”.

(260) The ultimate end of the whole divine economy (economy referring to all the ways and works by which God reveals himself and communicates his life) is the entry of God’s creatures into the perfect unity of the Blessed Trinity. But even now we are called to be a dwelling for the Most Holy Trinity: “If a man loves me”, says the Lord, “He will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and make our home with him” (John 14:23).

### **Prayer of Blessed Elizabeth of the Trinity**

O my God, Trinity whom I adore, help me forget myself entirely so to establish myself in you, unmovable and peaceful as if my soul were already in eternity. May nothing be able to trouble my peace or make me leave you, O my unchanging God, but may each minute bring me more deeply into your mystery! Grant my soul peace. Make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling and the place of your rest. May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire, completely vigilant in my faith, entirely adoring, and wholly given over to your creative action.
