SAINT AUGUSTINE

Saint Augustine, Bishop of Hippo (what is now Annaba, Algeria) and Doctor of the Church, is perhaps best known for his Confessions that trace the story of his conversion. He was also an extraordinary pastor and teacher.

His Feast Day is August 28.

The "Confessions of Saint Augustine" contain many beautiful and powerful prayers that have been collected in a book entitled (what else?), "Prayers from the Confessions". Here is the first excerpt, familiar to many, though in a new translation.

Our Heart is Un-quiet Until It Rests in You

"Great are you, O Lord, and exceedingly worthy of praise; your power is immense, and your wisdom beyond reckoning.

And so we humans, who are due part of your creation, long to praise you – we who carry our mortality about with us, carry the evidence of our sin and with is the proof that you thwart the proud.

Yet these humans, dur part of your creation as they are, still do long to praise you.

You stir us so that praising you may bring us joy, because you have made us and drawn us to yourself, and our heart is unquiet until it rests in you."
