Dear Parents:

Thanks so much for entrusting your child to our care on Sunday morning at QAS School of Religion – Level 3. We're looking forward to a terrific year of fun as we get to know each other, learn about our religion and study the Bible together in lots of interesting ways.

Sunday School affirms the home as the center of biblical guidance. Parents are the most important people in a child's life, and learning about God starts in the home. Teaching children about God is a seven-day-a-week effort, not something that can be done just an hour or two on Sunday morning. We pledge to do our best to support you in your child's spiritual education, and stand ready to help you at any time.

As you know, each Sunday we meet in St. Joseph hall, we welcome your stopping by and joining us at prayer. Please inform us if there should be any special arrangements for your child when class is over. Encourage Regular Attendance

Please help your child to be on time and **attend often**, and encourage your child to bring a text book, Bible and other material to class. We prepare carefully each week to begin meaningful teaching from the very beginning of the class, and your child's arrival on time and preparedness, helps the whole class to get the most out of the session. If possible, pack Sunday school bag a day or two before Sunday.

Pray

We believe that **prayer is an effective and powerful** force to help protect your child and help him develop to his highest spiritual potential. We would much appreciate your prayers for us and the class as well.

In addition, we encourage your child to develop the habit of a daily quiet time with God, reading daily devotional thoughts and scripture verses and **praying before each meal**.

Bring Offering

Encouraging children to **bring an offering** helps them develop good habits of stewardship. It is an opportunity to discuss how the money is used to provide services and ministry at our church and support missions around the world.

Please be sure that children complete homework assignments. Each week part of the homework is to complete the **correlated Art page at the back** of the text book. Other assignments will be handed out, or children are offered an opportunity to annotate assignments. To provide the best learning experience, complete homework assignments on Sunday.
