Bishop DiMarzio has designated December 1, 2019 as Red Ribbon Sunday, a day of prayer for the Diocese of Brooklyn in honor of persecuted Christians throughout the world.

November 23, Aid to the Church in Need will hold a *Night of Witness* at the National Shrine, which can be viewed on NET TV.

November 24, Feast of Christ the King, pastors have been asked to light their church in red to show solidarity with churches throughout the world.

December 1, Red Ribbon Sunday, we will ask our parishioners to hang Red Ribbons on the trees, fences and light poles around their homes to help extend the awareness of persecution beyond the wall of our churches to the wider community. The ribbons should be kept up until the Epiphany on January 6, 2020.

Students of Faith Formation will be receiving one Red Ribbon bracelet on November 24, 2019 for the purpose mentioned above.
