



TWO DECEMBER FRIDAY EVENINGS AT QAS WITH FATHER ROBERT LAUDER

Father Robert E. Lauder, who led the very well received parish retreat last month at the seminary in Huntington NY, will be coming to Queen of All Saints for two Friday evenings in December to discuss Catholic film and the Catholic novel. Since 1968 Father Lauder has conducted film festivals twice a year at the Immaculate Conception Center in Douglaston. He also appears regularly on the NET Catholic TV station in the program "The Catholic Novel". We're delighted to have him here to present and lead discussions in both of those areas.

FILM

On **Friday December 6**, we will show the film "**Return to Me**". This 2000 romantic comedy-drama directed by Bonnie Hunt stars David Duchovny, Minnie Driver, Carroll O'Connor (in his last film before his death), Robert Loggia and Jim Belushi. The movie runs just under two hours.

Father Lauder will provide an introduction to the movie and lead a discussion after its conclusion.

NOVELS

On **Friday, December 13**, Father Lauder will give a talk and lead a discussion on the Catholic novel. The title of his presentation will be "**The Place of the Catholic Novel in the Secular City**".

Included in Father Lauder's presentation will be recommended Catholic novels for our consideration. Hopefully, after selecting one or two, we can bring Father Lauder back to Queen of All Saints for a discussion after the new year.

Both evenings will begin at 7:30 in Saint Joseph's Hall and refreshments will be available.
