Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Under the title of the Immaculate Conception, Mary is the patroness of the United States and of the Diocese of Brooklyn.

This Solemnity, and Holy day of *obligation*, is normally celebrated each year on December 8th. However, because the 8th falls on a Sunday, the feast has been moved to Monday December 9th. For that reason (occurring on a Monday) it is not a holy day with the *obligation* to attend Mass in the United States.

We will honor this Solemnity of our Lady at the 8:30 AM Mass (sung) on Monday, December 9th.

If you are able, I sincerely encourage you to attend Mass, here or at a church near your workplace, particularly since Mary is also the patroness of our parish.

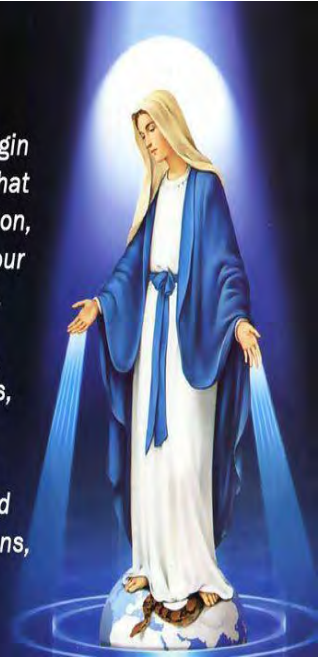
