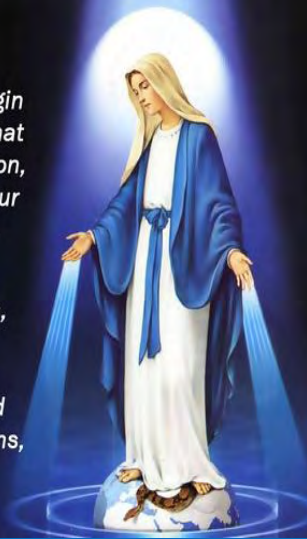
**PARISH WEEKLY GOAL**
