CONFIRMATION

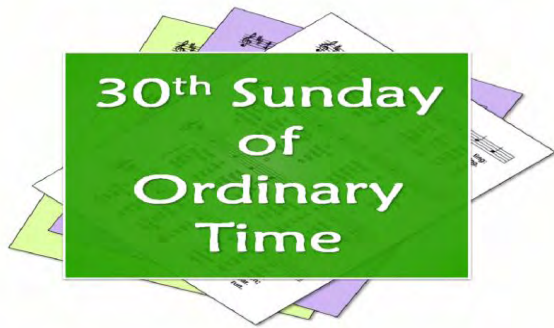
