GOD'S JOY, AND OURS

Of all the attributes of God, the one that is often neglected by theologians and preachers is God's joy. So weighed down with so many inhibitors of joy are we, that we cannot begin to conceive the utter joyfulness of God. As a result, we are not much moved by the prospect of sharing in that state; eye has not seen, nor ear heard nor has the human heart conceived what God has prepared for those who love him.

God is the boundless sea of happiness, a Trinity of blessedness, a communion of joy. This joy is not subject to diminishment by the action of others nor by any intrinsic limitation or weakness.

God created us to share that joy, placing man and woman in a garden of delights. But we fell from joy, preferring an independent life of pain and tragedy, hiding from the source of our own ultimate happiness.

God would not accept our fallen state and constantly sang to us the songs of Zion, trying to wean our hearts from sadness and remind us of the blessed homeland to which we are called.

Through prophets and sages, he strove to open our hearts to receive his messengers of love. The angel appeared to Mary and said, "Rejoice!" And then, in the last times, God sang the Song of his own joy, the word who is living expression amongst us of all God is.

And so the Word was made flesh and God's joy lived amongst us. Jesus, a man overflowing with attractiveness of divine joy. Not only the "man of sorrows" of whom some speak, but one who said, "May my joy be within you." He lived a life that we are called to imitate so that we might become sharers in the divine nature. So filled with joy was Jesus that the sadness of death could not overcome it. He rose, conqueror of death, breathing out on the world the spirit of joy.

Joy is the most infallible sign of the presence of God. God is joy, and those who abide in joy abide in God and God in them.

Father most holy, show us your face and we shall be saved. Unveil to us the mystery of your love, and we fill us with the gift of your Holy Spirit so that all that we do may be radiant with your joy. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord.
