ALL SAINTS DAY – November 1st

This Tuesday, November 1st is All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation. On this day we celebrate the lives of all the saints...those who have gone before us who lived the Christian life with heroic commitment and virtue in the midst of all of life's struggles and difficulties. The saints reflect the "richness of God's goodness...through whom God's own light becomes visible" (Pope Benedict XVI).
