“There is a world of difference between a naïve optimism and the theological certainty that all things work together unto good for those who love God. A belief in God’s providence is not a blindness to sometimes-horrendous reality. Nor is it an invitation to fatalism. It is the overriding confidence that God understands the totality of our situation much better than we do ourselves; our purview is limited.

It is true that God saves us by mighty acts of deliverance. It is also true that God saves us by causing us or allowing us to pass through hard times. By breaking open the complacent carapace of our lives, God exposes us to influences that force us to backpedal, to change tactics, to learn new skills, to move into unexplored territory.

Mostly, this is unwelcome change, but, despite our grimaces, it is beneficent. We are being delivered from self-imposed limitations that have hitherto inhibited our lives. We are being freed from the moribund staleness we have embraced and invited, if not to be reborn, at least to begin a new stage in life.

All that comes from the hand of God is good; if we can accept this our lives would be both happier and more purposeful.

Creator and sustainer God, in love you have made the world, and in your love you guide it to a joyous culmination. Give us faith and hope that will sustain our confidence when life is difficult and strengthen us by your grace to respond in love to whatever befalls us. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.”
